UNL is now participating in a program to prove the medical status of each individual each time they enter a building on campus. They must show the “Safer” Communities app that will indicate if they have been vaccinated or if they have a weekly negative covid test. **This is a de facto vaccine passport!** This is the equivalent of being asked to “show your papers”.

This totalitarianism will not stop here. If our young college age adults learn to accept that they must prove their worth to access public spaces and have freedom of movement, they will be primed to accept more and more restrictions.

It is a clear violation of our first amendment rights to freedom of movement to restrict access based on medical status, not to mention our right to privacy. **No one should ever have to reveal personal health information to get access to a public space.**
